The position will also offer assistance and support to the staff of the Parish Resource and Internal Audit Offices, in the areas of parish and diocesan department reviews, payroll transactions and associated reports, accounting transactions and associated reports, internal controls, tax, best business practices. This position also serves as backup for critical staff within the fiscal office in the accounting and payroll areas. Due to the sensitive nature of the workings of the finance office, confidentiality is an essential requirement of the position.
